2. Regulatory Authorisation

Patt Investment AG is authorised by the Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority (FINMA) as a portfolio manager (independent asset manager) pursuant to Financial Institutions Act (FinIA).

Ongoing prudential supervision is carried out by Swiss Financial Market Supervisory Authority (FINMA).

Activity: portfolio management of client assets held at an independent regulated custodian bank (Julius Bär & Co. AG), in accounts opened in the client's own name. The Company does NOT take deposits and does NOT itself hold client assets.

3. Verification of Regulatory Status

The authorisation of Patt Investment AG can be independently verified in the public register maintained by FINMA.

4. Regulatory Framework

Patt Investment AG operates under Financial Institutions Act (FinIA) and is subject to ongoing supervision.

Regulatory obligations include: organisational and capital requirements, rules on the handling of client assets, AML/KYC obligations, conduct of business standards, and reporting requirements.

5. Client Protection

Supervision provides oversight of the Company's conduct and organisation, but does NOT guarantee investment performance or the value of client assets.

Clients should conduct their own due diligence before entering into any asset management relationship.
